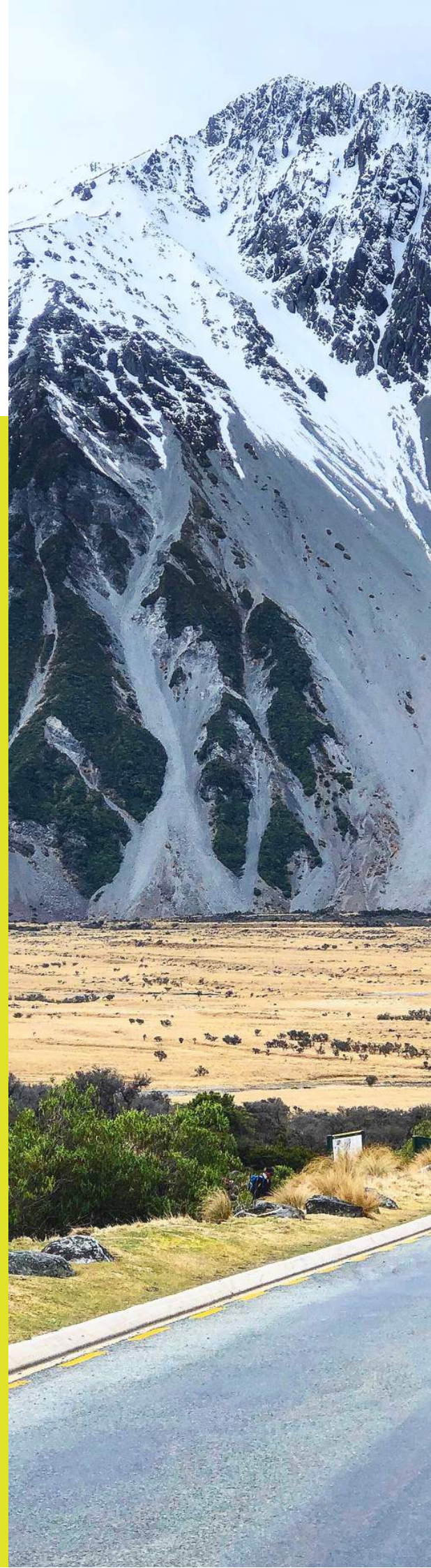
# PACKING LIST

## Toiletries

- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Shampoo and conditioner
- Body wash or soap
- Deodorant
- Moisturizer (skin can get very dry in cold weather)
- Lip balm with SPF
- Sunscreen
- Hand cream
- Medications and vitamins
- First aid kit
- Feminine hygiene products
- Razor and shaving cream
- Hairbrush and hair ties

## Health + Safety

- Personal medications and prescriptions
- Pain relievers and fever reducers
- Cold and flu medicine
- Cough drops or throat lozenges
- Hand sanitizer and wet wipes
- Tissues
- Plasters/Band-aids
- Antiseptic cream
- Water purification tablets or water filter bottle

## Technology

- Smartphone and charger
- Power bank
- Camera, batteries, and charger
- Plug adapter and voltage converter
- Headphones or earbuds
- Tablet or e-reader loaded with books/movies

## Entertainment

- Books/Magazines
- Travel games or cards
- Portable Speaker
- Notebook and Pen

## Food + Drink

- Reusable water bottle with insulation
- Non-perishable snacks (trail mix, energy bars, etc.)
- Reusable cutlery and containers
- Thermos for hot beverages

# PACKING LIST

## Outdoor Equipment

- Skis, snowboards, and related gear (if applicable)
- Helmets, goggles, and other protective gear
- Hand and foot warmers
- Snowshoes (if applicable)
- Maps and compass or GPS device for backcountry travel

## Money + Payments

- Wallet
- Credit/debit cards (inform your bank about your travel plans)
- Cash in local currency
- Money belt or neck pouch for valuables

## Miscellaneous

- Luggage tags
- Laundry bag and travel detergent
- Plastic or reusable bags for wet or dirty clothing
- Notebook and pen
- Umbrella
- Locks for luggage
- Sewing kit
